

I formally object to the 291.03-hectare Ashley submission (12 sites) in the Cheshire East SHELAA. These sites must be classified as **Unsuitable and Undeliverable**:

- **Green Belt Breach:** As strategic "wash-over" Green Belt preventing sprawl between Greater Manchester and Cheshire, it fails national "Grey Belt" release criteria.
- **BMV Agricultural Loss:** Irreparably destroys Grade 2 and 3a Best and Most Versatile farmland protected for food security.
- **Hierarchy & Infrastructure:** Unsustainable rural location lacking transport, utilities, surface-water drainage, and basic services.
- **Heritage & Safety Harm:** Conflicts with aviation safety zones, exacerbates River Bollin flood risks, and damages ancient woodlands and 19 Listed Buildings.
